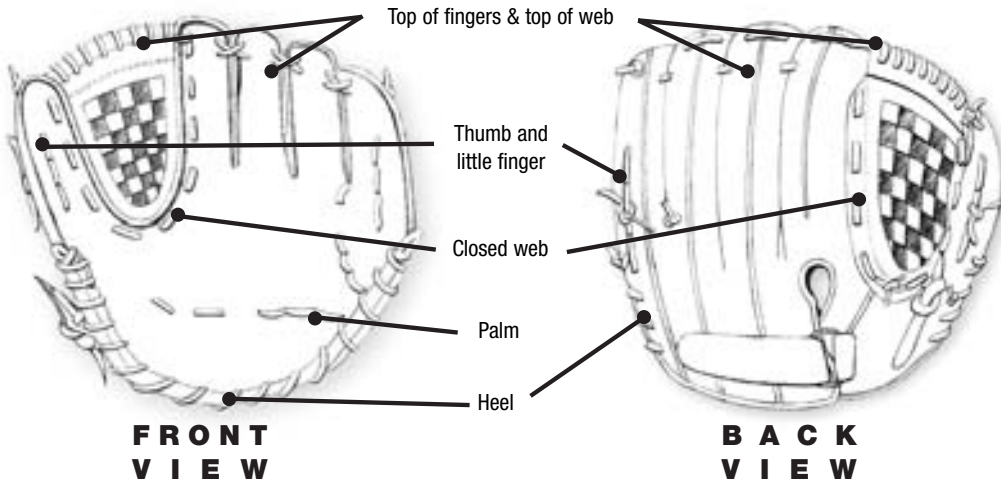


# RELACER™

## PROFESSIONAL BALL GLOVE REPAIR KIT

Your glove may not be identical to these illustrations. Examine your glove's unique lacing pattern before relacing.



### Before you begin

Use these instructions and lace for most models of Pitcher's, Infield and Outfield gloves only. No two glove models are exactly alike. These instructions provide general guidelines to help teach the basics of glove relacing.

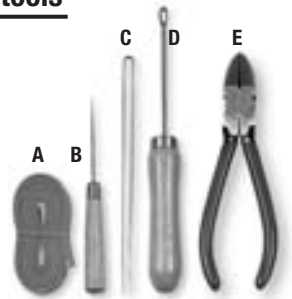
Remove worn laces from the area of the glove to be relaced. (You may choose to remove lace one step at a time and follow the path of the old lace.) Then, use the entire 72" lace and punch a hole through the end with the Leather Punch. Follow the diagrams carefully.

The web and top fingers need relacing more often than any other part of the glove. If you decide to relace the entire glove at one time, begin with the palm.

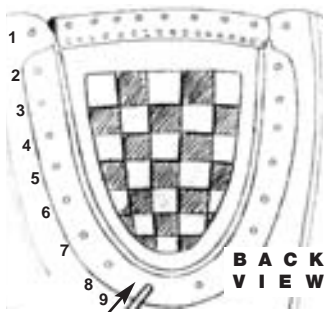
### Use the proper tools

- A** (3) 72" Laces (laces an entire glove)
  - B** Leather Punch (makes hole in lace)
  - C** U-Wire Needle (laces the glove)
  - D** Steel Lacing Tool (makes hole wider) (can also lace glove)
  - E** Leather Cutter\* (trims lace)
- \*included with JMRLP-B/T models only

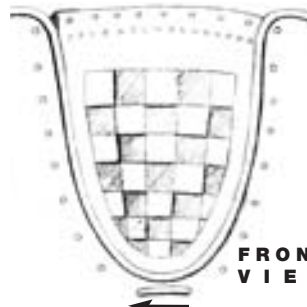

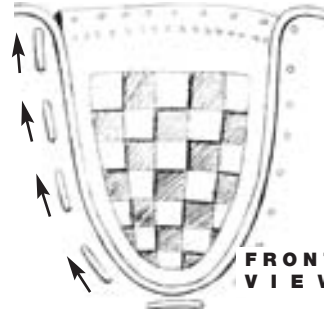
## Lacing the Closed Web



**A** Insert the lace through the back of the 9th hole, leaving approximately 4".



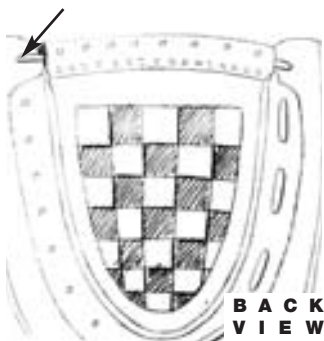
**B** Pull lace through the front, then insert the lace into the next hole.



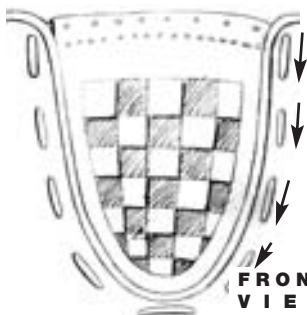
**C** Repeat the pattern, continuing through the back and front, until you reach the top of the thumb.



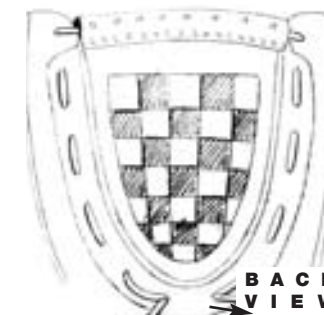
**D** Insert the lace into the top of web and pull all the way through to the finger.



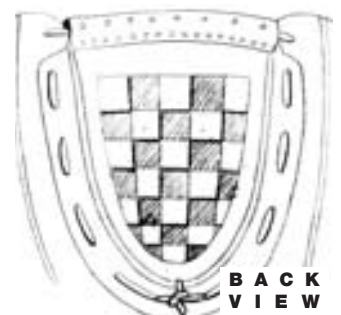
**E** Insert into the top hole of the finger.



**F** Repeat the pattern, continuing until you reach the bottom.



**G** Insert lace into the 9th hole, the same hole you originally started from.



**H** Cut the lace. Leave enough to tie a knot.
